- 2) **List the jobs you have held. For each job list the Employer, Position, Dates of Employment and Description of the work.***
- 3) **Please write a paragraph telling us why you want to work at Fermilab this summer.*** (2000 characters)
- 4) **Please write a paragraph telling us which areas or projects you would be most interested in working on and why.*** (2000 characters) Fermilab science projects:

- 5) **Briefly discuss what attracted you to your major and your career plans. Are you planning on attending graduate school? Going into industry, R&D, etc.?** (2000 characters max)

- 7) **Based on a 4.0 scale, what is your overall GPA?** (500 characters max)
- 8) **What is your anticipated graduation date?** (500 characters max)
- 9) **Please provide any additional information that will help the committee evaluate your application more fully.** (2000 characters max) **TIP: This is where you can convince the committee you are a good fit for the internship. Talk about any personal or academic experiences or challenges you’ve had that make you especially prepared for this opportunity.**
- 10) **Are you a member or have you attended a conference for any professional organizations?***
